Instructions for Activating Your Online Subscription

As with most electronic periodicals, there are step-by-step instructions that must be followed to enable you to receive your online issue of *Psychiatric Services*. Please follow the procedures outlined below.

Make sure you have your customer identification number available. This number is printed on your mailing label, directly above your name and address. If you cannot locate this number, please contact American Psychiatric Publishing, Inc., through one of the following methods:

Click on the “Subscriptions” button located near the bottom of the page. Then click on the appropriate link:

- ◆ **ACTIVATE Your Institutional Subscription**

of the online subscription before starting the subscription process. Before entering your customer number in the box provided, follow the instructions below.

For APA Members: You will find your member number on the mailing label above your name. It is a 10-digit number beginning with zeros. Enter your number in the box and click the SUBMIT button.

For Individual Nonmembers and Institutions: Your customer number is on the mailing label above your name. It is a 10-digit number beginning with 22 or 30. Enter this number in the box and click the SUBMIT button.

Fill out all the information on the next screen and press the “Send Form” button at the bottom on the right. **DO NOT CLICK** the “Clear Form” button.

Institutional Subscribers Only

After completing the above steps, you will be brought to the screen to enter the IP addresses for your institution. These IP addresses should conform to the Terms and Conditions of your license. Read the “Help with IP Addresses” to see how to enter IP ranges.

When finished, click the “Done” button. You will receive an e-mail confirmation that your subscription has been activated.

U.S. and Canadian members of APA may obtain a free print subscription by completing and returning the request form available at www.psych.org/ps. International members can return the request form to obtain an online-only subscription. For nonmembers, one-year subscriptions (12 issues) within the U.S. are \$96 for individuals. Subscriptions outside the U.S. are \$195 for individuals.

Individuals can purchase an online-only subscription for \$87 per year (\$28 for students).

**Address Changes and
Subscription Inquiries**
